

2013 ESTATE GRENACHE: Welcome to the Rhone with an elegant and clean expression of this elusive varietal. Fruit characters combine raspberry juice, dark plum, sweet tangerine and juicy fruit gum accented by sweet pipe tobacco and smoky tobacco leaf. With some structure on the mid-palate, this wine finishes with a nearly savory, fruit forward softness.

Drink now through 2025.
